

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION BATTERY WARNINGS AND PROPER USE

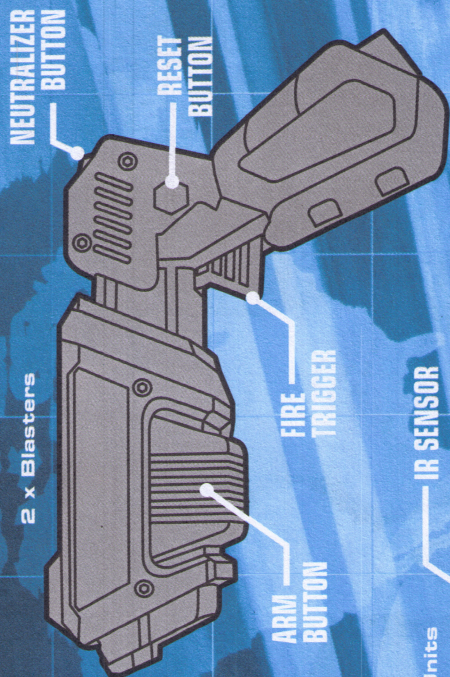

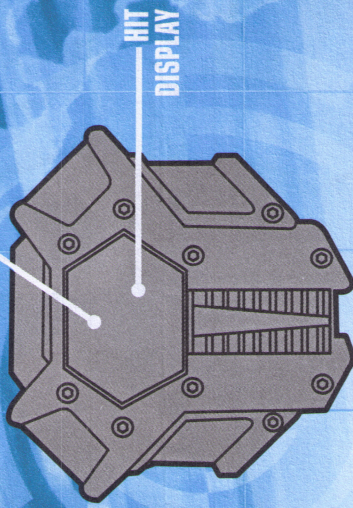


LASER DUELING SYSTEM DIAGRAM

STARTING THE GAME

POWER ON

- Turn your Blaster and Target Unit on by sliding the on/off switch (located on the back of the Target Unit) to the "on" position (Fig. 2).

- Locate the RESET button (R) on the left side of the Blaster (Fig. 3).

NOTE: RESET ALL BLASTERS BEFORE STARTING A GAME!

- To begin a game or reset an opponent's Blaster, aim your Blaster at that opponent's Target Unit and press the Reset button on your Blaster.

RELOAD

- In order to fire, you must reload your Blaster. To reload, press the Arm Button under the Blaster barrel (Fig. 4).
- Each reload will give you 25 shots.
- Your Blaster can rapid-fire by pressing the trigger repeatedly.

- When you are out of shots you will hear a "click" from your Blaster indicating that you need to reload.

NOTE: You can reload as many times as you wish in each game.

HITS

- Once your Blaster has been reset, your Target Unit can be hit.
- Each time the Target Unit is hit, the electronic display will flash and the "hit" sounds will be heard.
- On the 9th hit, a warning tone will alert the player that they can only be hit one more time.
- On the 10th hit, the player is eliminated and the Blaster will shut down.

NEUTRALIZER

- To Neutralize your opponent, press the Neutralizer button and aim towards an opponent (Fig. 5).
- This feature will disable your opponent's Blaster for 15 seconds.
- This can give you time to escape or prepare for an attack.

NOTE: You can only use your Neutralizer feature 1 time per game.

TO USE YOUR 3D SPY CARDS

- 1) Click on the 3D Cards tab on the SpyNet™ HQ Website (www.SpyNetHQ.com).
- 2) On the 3D Cards page, select your card's toy icon from the list.
- 3) After the page loads, you should see the camera view from your webcam onscreen.
- 4) Hold your 3D Spy Card up about 6-12 inches (15-30 centimeters) from your webcam, making sure that the entire face of the card can be seen onscreen.
- 5) You'll then see a 3D model of your toy appear onscreen. Cover the **R** button with your finger to have information windows about the toy pop up onscreen. Cover the **C** button with your finger to cycle to another 3D toy model.



HOLD 3D SPY CARD APPROXIMATELY ~ 6-12 INCHES/15-30 CENTIMETERS FROM WEBCAM

FOR SET-UP: (ADULT INSTALLATION REQUIRED)

Requires 6 AAA (LR03) alkaline battery (not included)

Battery installation:

- Each Target Unit requires 3 AAA (LR03) alkaline batteries.
- NOTE: No batteries are required for the Blaster.
- NOTE: SpyNet Laser Strike™ equipment works best with new batteries.

Locate the battery compartment underneath the unit. Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove the screw and the battery door. Install a fresh battery, matching polarity icons with those on the unit. Replace the battery compartment and the screw.

When operating in environments that are subject to electrostatic discharges, the SpyNet Laser Strike™ may malfunction. If this occurs, the user should reset the unit by using the on/off switch.

- Put on your target by sliding your arm through the strap, and adjust the strap to fit your arm (Fig. 1).

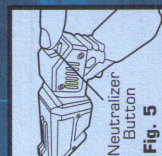
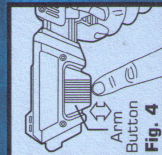
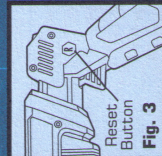
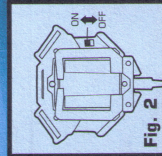
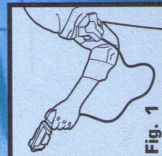
